

# Classification of PG Medical Seats in Karnataka & Eligibility Criteria

## Government Seats (G)

- 100% of Seats in Government colleges
- 33% of Seats in Private Non-Minority colleges
- 20% of Seats in Private Minority (Religious & Linguistic) colleges

### Eligibility for Government Seats

Candidate should be a citizen of India, who has obtained MBBS degree in a medical college situated in Karnataka recognized by MCI and has qualified in NEET PG 2019.

## Private Seats (P)

- 42% seats reserved as private quota seats in non-minority medical colleges
  1. 50% of the above 42% seats are referred as GMP seats/GMP with Hyd-Kar seats in case of colleges located in Hyd-Kar region).
  2. Remaining 50% of the above 42% seats are “OPEN” quota seats that are filled based on NEET PG All India merit and only Citizens of India are eligible.
- 55% of seats reserved as private quota seats in minority medical colleges
  1. 66% of the above seats will be filled by respective religious / linguistic minority candidates (MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats).
  2. 34% of the above seats are filled as follows:
    - a) 50% of the above 34% seats are GMP seats.
    - b) 50% of the above 34% seats are reserved for All India candidates who are Citizen of India (OPN seats).

### Eligibility for Private Seats

**OPN Seats:** Candidate should be a citizen of India who has obtained MBBS degree in a medical college affiliated to any university recognized by MCI and has qualified in NEET PG 2019.

**Religious Minority (MM, MC) seats:** Candidate should be a citizen of India who has obtained MBBS degree in a medical college affiliated to any university recognized by MCI, should be qualified in NEET PG 2019, and belongs to any of the following categories.

- Christian Minority of Karnataka & Non-Karnataka
- Muslim Minority of Karnataka & Non- Karnataka

**Linguistic Minority (MA, ME, MK, MU):** Candidate should be a citizen of India who has obtained MBBS degree in a medical college affiliated to any university recognized by MCI, should be qualified in NEET PG 2019, and belongs to linguistic minority of the Karnataka state whose mother tongue is Tamil or Telugu or Kodava or Tulu.

**St. John's Medical College Bangalore:** The following candidates shall be eligible for St. John's Medical College

- Roman Catholic Religious Nuns & Priests with SJMC approved rural service
- SJMC Alumni with rural service
- Roman Catholic

### **NRI Seats (N)**

15% of the total PG medical seats reserved for NRI quota in minority and non-minority Private Medical Colleges in Karnataka.

#### **Eligibility for NRI Seats**

Candidate should have obtained MBBS degree in a MCI approved medical college, and should be an NRI or ward of NRI or PIO or OCI or Foreign Nationals.

### **Others Seats (Q)**

10% of the total PG medical seats reserved for others in minority and non-minority Private Medical Colleges in Karnataka.

#### **Eligibility for Others Seats**

Candidate should have obtained MBBS degree in a medical college affiliated to any University recognized by MCI and Govt. of India and should have qualified in NEET PG 2019. NRI / PIO / OCI and Foreign Nationals are not eligible for Q seats.

### **Reservation for Persons with disabilities**

5% of the Government seats will be reserved in favor of Persons with Benchmark disabilities.
